

ISASP Testing





2nd Semester Updates

<u>**Grades**</u>: Last week we sent out 1st semester/2nd quarter grades. If you ever have any questions about grades please reach out to your student's teacher(s). Grades can be accessed at any time on JMC by students & parents. Once a week during advisory (touch base Tuesday) we have our students check their grades on JMC.

Parent communication: One of our goals this year has been to increase communication & engagement with parents. At WCVMS, minor behavior infractions are documented as "strikes" or "documented behaviors." When a student accumulates an excessive amount of strikes in a certain time period, parents/guardians will be notified by email from their student's teachers. In cases of "major" behaviors, the principal will reach out to the parent/guardian. We believe that if we provide clear & consistent learning environments while keeping parents informed, students will thrive academically.

Attendance: Even with the recent illnesses that have been going around, our attendance has been <u>much better</u> than it was last year. Last year's 1st semester daily attendance rate was 92.9%. This year the first semester daily attendance rate was at 93.91%. This is a significant improvement and we appreciate your help in getting the kids to school. We also really appreciate the fact that we have been receiving doctor's notes to excuse absences. With the new attendance laws, most absences can not be excused without a doctor's note. Thank you for your help in getting those notes to us!
