Preschool students went on a field trip to the Stuart Care Center on and much fun was had by all. Thank you to all the Staff and Parents who made this a memorable day!



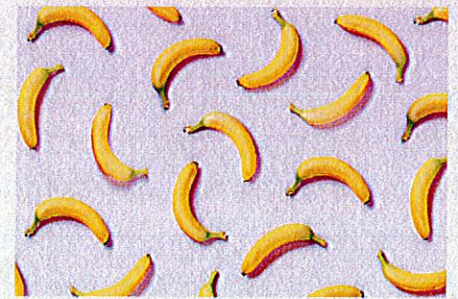




## STUART PBIS

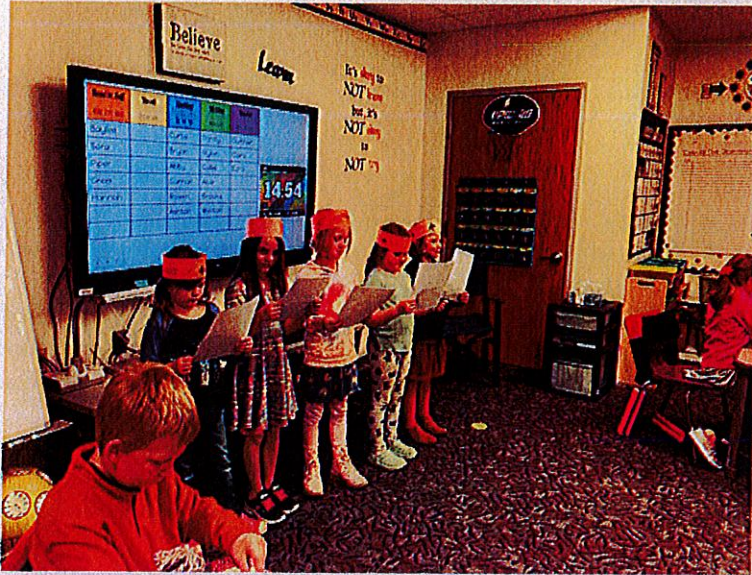
## DEXTER PBIS
